Research Code of Conduct

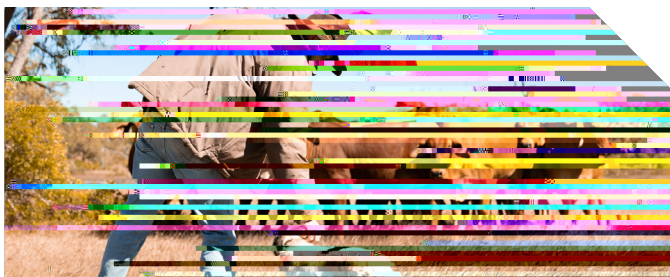
The Australian Code of Research Ethics provides the ethical framework for research involving animals or humans. JCU has adopted the principles in the [Code of Research Ethics of Research](#). The code of ethics in research and how to follow it:

- Manage breaches of the Code and allegation of research misconduct;
- Manage research data and materials;
- Publish and disseminate research findings, including publication of a report;
- Conduct research ethically;
- Manage conflicts of interest.

Your JCU Research Ethics Advisory Committee is responsible for the implementation of the Code.

Animal Welfare and Ethics

Animal welfare is a priority for all research involving animals. Research involving animals can only be conducted in compliance with the relevant legislation, and

Clinical Trial

A clinical trial is a form of human research designed to find out the effects of an intervention, including a treatment or diagnostic procedure.

Clinical trials in Australia are conducted in accordance with the National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research and the current Australian Government Therapeutic Goods Administration legislation. Dealing with the name of the trial, JCU's Health Service Director Human Research Ethics Committee will review the trial. Clinical trials may be registered in the publicly accessible database Australian New Zealand Clinical Trial Register.
