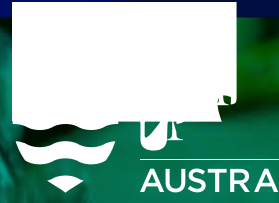

- ✔ Benefit from a multi-faceted approach to learning. Undertake an individual research project, or take advantage of a domestic or international internship that will expand your professional network.
- ✔ Fast-track your degree with credit for previous study. If you have a Bachelor's degree or a Graduate Certificate in a related discipline, you may be able to complete the Master's degree in 1.5 years. If you have a Bachelor Honours degree or a Graduate Diploma in a related discipline, you may be able to complete the Master's degree in 1 year.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You'll need to include certified copies of qualifications and academic records with your application. For some programs, appropriate work experience or equivalent qualifications will be considered.
